There was also a Youth Panel, a Business Panel and a Women in Business Panel. Overall, along with various other business-related workshops the IBBS had a very positive evaluation about the event even though it was held online. During the Pandemic the Treaty Seven Resource Group maintained communication to ensure the clients were always communicated with and had a voice and someone was available to assist them and their businesses.</p>
